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Executive Summary

This business plan is prepared to outline the activities of Fort McMurray branch for the year 2004-2005 as set out in the annual planning session meeting.

The purpose of the business plan is to describe the goals of 2004/2005 branch executive and to provide a brief outlook to APEGGA head office on how our branch activity aligns with the over goal of APEGGA.
