## **Difference Between Professional Licensee And Professional Member**

### **Professional Licensee**

The Professional Licensee (P.L.) designation is a professional license allowing you to practice engineering or geoscience within a clearly defined scope of practice. Professional Licensees are permitted to independently practice engineering, geology or geophysics in Alberta within narrow, defined scopes of practice and to take responsibility for that work. This category of licensure recognizes that certain qualified individuals can be permitted to independently carry out certain specific functions normally within the definition of professional engineering, professional geology or professional geophysics without the supervision of a Professional Engineer, Professional Geologist or Professional Geophysicist. Professional Licensees typically have an academic background of technologist diplomas.

### **Professional Members**

The Professional Member designation is a professional license allowing you to practice engineering or geoscience in Alberta and take responsibility for that work. Only engineers and geoscientists licensed with APEGGA, or those practicing under the direct supervision of someone with a P.Eng, P.Geol or P.Geoph license with APEGGA, have a legal right to practice engineering in Alberta.
