The SR&ED program is complex, with both tax and science components contributing to its eligibility, the submission process and the calculation of the benefit. This session is designed to provide an overview of the program rules, and some guidance to engineers and (geo)scientists to familiarize them with not only how the submission process works, but also what they can do to expedite this process and improve the documentation supporting SR&ED claim.
