

## APEGGA Professional Licensee (Engineering) Committee Volunteer Positions Available

Are you a seasoned Professional Engineer with ten or more years of industry experience seeking an opportunity to advance the profession by sharing your knowledge and experience?

APEGGA is looking for Professional Engineers to fill volunteer positions in the newly created APEGGA Professional Licensee (Engineering) Committee (the “Committee”) arising as a result of legislative changes converting the Registered Professional Technologist (“R.P.T.”) designation to Professional Licensee (“P.Lic.”).

The Committee will perform the work previously done by the ASET Registered Professional Technologist (Engineering) Nominating Committee. The Committee will provide assistance to the APEGGA Board of Examiners by conducting initial reviews of Professional Licensee [“P.Lic (Eng)”] applications for compliance with the minimum eligibility criteria under the legislation and to review that the applicant’s proposed defined scope of practice is appropriate to the applicant’s academic training and work experience.

### **Qualifications**

Applicants must:

- Be licensed as a P.Eng. with APEGGA, and
- Have a minimum of ten years of industry experience within the relevant discipline

We welcome volunteers from all disciplines and in particular have a need for individuals with experience in:

- chemical engineering
- civil engineering
- electrical engineering
- mechanical engineering
- petroleum engineering
- instrumentation and controls

### **Duties and Expectations of Members**

The Committee will meet as required depending on the volume and complexity of applications received. We expect the Committee may need to meet four to six times per year. Meetings will normally be one-half day each and may alternate between face to face meetings and videoconference meetings from APEGGA’s Edmonton and Calgary offices. Authorized travel expenses will be reimbursed. In addition, subcommittee meetings may be called from time to time.

The duties and expectations of Committee members are:

- Serve a three-year term
- Attend meetings regularly

- Participate in subcommittee meetings as required
- Review individual application files between meetings
- Review agenda materials in preparation for meetings
- Contact applicants and references as required to clarify education, experience, or defined scope of practice
