## MANDATORY REPORTING REQUIREMENT

## Please read carefully

All Professional Members, Licensees, and Registered Professional Technologists (RPTs) are required to report their professional development hours annually. The following are exempt from this requirement:

- Students, Examination Candidates and Members-in-Training
- Professional Members, Licensees and RPTs who have filed a "non-practicing" declaration.

If you are not engaged in active practice and wish to be exempted from **future** CPD reporting requirements, please complete and submit the *Non-Practicing Declaration* on the reverse after having read it carefully. Please note that practicing is not considered as being limited to stamping professional documents; it includes acting as a Responsible Member for an APEGGA Permit and all activities contained in the definitions of "practice" under the *Engineering, Geological and Geophysical Professions Act*.

If you had previously declared yourself to be non-practicing and intend **to resume practice at any time**, you must obtain permission **before** doing so. Please contact the Professional Practice Department and request an application for resumption of practice or obtain it from the APEGGA web site at <u>www.apegga.org/Regulatory/CPD/toc.html</u>.

## Professional Development Hours (PDHs)

You must claim a minimum of 240 PDHs over three years, in at least three of the six categories. Please do not send any supporting documentation. You should, however, keep a detailed log of your activities for three years in the event you are required to produce it in the future.
