

REQUESTS FOR SPECIAL TESTING ACCOMMODATIONS

The goal of APEGA is to provide all qualified candidates access to the NPP Examination program. This includes disabled candidates who demonstrate functional limitations that affect their ability to take the exam and therefore, require reasonable modifications to the manner in which the test is administered. Examples of available accommodations include:

- Extended testing time
- Large-print exam booklets
- Extra breaks
- Reduced-distraction testing rooms

How to make a request

If you wish to request special testing accommodations due to a documented disability, you will be required to submit current documentation (within the last three years) on a qualified professional's letterhead, describing in detail the limitations caused by the diagnosed disability, along with an explanation of why these accommodations are needed.

This information must accompany your Application to Write the NPP Examination and be submitted well in advance of the examination session deadline in order to review the documentation and subject to approval, make the necessary arrangements to accommodate your request.

Requests received after the deadline will result in your exam application being deferred to the next session.
