Local Students Honoured for Excellence in Education

Lethbridge – Two area residents, Adrian Boere and Allen Reule, have been awarded \$3,000 scholarships from the Education Foundation of The Association of Professional Engineers, Geologists and Geophysicists of Alberta (APEGGA).

Boere, who is attending the University of Alberta, is the recipient of the APEGGA Wallace L. Foss Lethbridge Transfer Scholarship, awarded on the basis of academic achievement to students completing an engineering, geological or geophysical technology program who are continuing their studies in engineering, geology or geophysics at the University of Alberta or the University of Calgary.

Reule, who is also attending the University of Alberta, received an APEGGA University Entrance Scholarship, presented to deserving students who have achieved a high academic standing in Grade 12 Mathematics, Science and English and are entering the faculties of engineering or the departments of geology or geophysics at the University of Alberta, the University of Calgary or colleges and technical institutes in Alberta offering transfer programs.

In 2006, the APEGGA Education Foundation awarded 38 scholarships totaling \$103,000 to high school and post-secondary students from across Alberta who are pursuing a career in the professions of engineering, geology or geophysics.
